Overall width in system 6 equals the width of the base of the blind.

Comments:

(1) **Silver anodized** only possible with rail A-2006.

(2) When ordering motorised blinds, please indicate the location of the motor (Right/Left and Front/Back) – rail A-2000 only.

(3) The standard length of pulling cords equals $\frac{3}{4}$ overall length of the blind.

(4) Should you select no option in column 14, the manufacturer will assume that the product is intended for rooms young children have access to (length of operating chains/cords compliant with PN-EN 13120:2014+A1 standard).

1. The standard blind is fitted with A-2000 rail, a link runner with a hook and a B1 bracket in white.

1. The standard blind is fitted with A 2000.
2. In system 5 the width is divided in half.

2. In system 3 the width is divided in half.
3. The slats for blinds of overall height over 4000 mm are sewn (not glued or welded).

4. Slanted vertical blinds are available with A-2006 rail only.
